The Audiocom system features a unique modular design which makes it easy to create intercom stations that will solve virtually any interpersonal communications requirement. Components such as power supplies, main stations, speaker/headset stations, belt packs, and a variety of headsets/microphones can be mixed and matched to produce a variety of powerful intercom stations. The three basic building blocks of an Audiocom intercom system are the Power Supplies, central Master Stations, and remote User Stations.

Power Supplies — Each independent channel of intercom must have an appropriate power supply in line to power the station equipment connected on that channel. There are several Power Supply options to meet the power demands of each system design. A single 2 Amp Power Supply provides enough phantom power to operate at least 25 belt packs or headset stations.

Central Master Stations — A central Master Station starts with a 2-channel US2000A User Station. This unit is then combined with the appropriate Power Supply, a speaker and microphone or a headset. An ES4000A Expansion Station can then be added to provide an additional four channels of intercom. Up to four ES4000A expansion units can be added to create a system consisting of 18 channels. For each expansion unit added, a matching power supply must also be added.

Remote User Stations — Remote User Station equipment is placed at the location of each key person in the system. There are several different types of remote station equipment options — User Stations can be added in line, or flush-mount headset stations, or belt packs, or speaker stations in a variety of box style options. Select the type of station equipment that is the most appropriate for each individual user and then add the required headset/handset or microphone.

#### T W O C H A N N E L S

To create a 2-channel central Master Station, connect a US2000A User Station to an SPS2000A or PS2000L Power Supply. The Power Supply provides power for belt packs and other intercom stations on two party lines. The SPS2000A shown here has a built-in powered speaker which the station operator uses to listen to the party lines. The gooseneck microphone attached to the US2000A is used to talk back to the party lines. If your application will only require a headset, and will not need a microphone/speaker combination, you can substitute a PS2000L Power Supply which has no speaker. As you can see, the design is very flexible and forgiving of changes. In the configuration shown here, approximately 20 to 25 belt packs total can be powered on the two party lines.

### SIX CHANNELS

For a 6-channel central Master Station, connect an ES4000A Expansion Station to the US2000A. Then, connect the ES4000A to a PS4000 Power Supply. The PS4000 provides power for the four additional party lines. (For a remote 6-channel Master Station, use an XP-ES-4000 Breakout Panel to connect the remote ES4000A to the four existing party lines.) The ES4000A provides talk, listen, and call capability for the four additional party lines. Using a PS4000 Power Supply, approximately 20 to 25 belt packs total can be powered on the four additional party lines. To increase this, you can substitute two PS2000L Power Supplies for the PS4000 for a capacity of approximately 20 to 25 belt packs for the two lines (50 belt packs maximum for four lines). Or, four PS2000L Power Supplies can be used, one for each party line. Each party line will then have a capacity of 20 to 25 belt packs, or up to 100 belt packs total.

Note: Whenever PS2000L Power Supplies are used at a central Master Station instead of a PS4000, an XP-ES-4000 Breakout Panel is required to connect the ES4000A to the party lines.



#### TEN CHANNELS

For a 10-channel Master Station, connect another ES4000A Expansion Station to the ES4000A of the 6-channel master station. Then, add another PS4000 Power Supply to power the four additional party lines. Again, you can substitute multiple PS2000L Power Supplies to increase channel capacity. If you do this, you will need another XP-ES-4000 Breakout Panel to connect the second ES4000A to the four additional party lines.

Audiocom<sup>®</sup> Intercom Systems are typically powered from the same wires that transmit the voice audio and call signals throughout the intercom system. This is called phantom power because no separate power wires are visible. To phantom power a party line, you simply connect a special Audiocom phantom Power Supply somewhere in the line. It doesn't matter where, but typically the Power Supply is located at a Master Station if the intercom system has one. Audiocom phantom Power Supplies are available to power one, two, or four party lines.

Generally, you can count on being able to power most of your intercom stations from the phantom Power Supply on the party lines. For those rare occasions where you need to add more stations to a party line than the line will permit, or where you need very great operating distances, most of the various types of station equipment can be individually powered with a local Power Supply. (Please note: See Power Supply capacity and power draw per station on the specification page of this catalog to determine power requirements.)

The system Power Supply (HPS 17) will provide power for up to six Series 17 belt packs. The belt packs are small enough to fit into a shirt pocket and a lightweight headset is included with each. The interconnection between the Series 17 power supply and belt packs is accomplished with common flat telephone cable terminated with modular plugs (RJ11).

Note: The Series 17 system is a stand-alone system. It is not expandable and is not intended for connection to any of the Audiocom series equipment.

The Audiocom family includes several intercom stations designed exclusively for use with microphone headsets or telephone-style handsets. Additionally, there is a listen-only station designed for use with an earset.

The WM1000 and WM2000 Intercom Stations are designed for stationary, wall mount installation in standard doublewide electrical outlet boxes. They connect to the intercom system using commonly available 22 gauge cable. Wall mount stations can be installed at strategic locations throughout a building. The user need only connect a headset or telephone style handset to begin communicating. The BP-1000, BP-2000, and IC-2B Belt Pack Intercom Stations are ideal for users who will be stationed in a general work area, but who need some mobility and wish to keep their hands free. Belt packs can be connected in a daisy chain directly back to the intercom system Power Supply or Master Station using prefabricated, low-impedance microphone cables. This is ideal for completely portable intercom systems. Alternatively, passive wall connector plates can be permanently installed at strategic locations, and the belt packs can then be connected to these using cables. This approach cuts down on the amount of cabling in the work area.
